Sat morning: Worship, teaching, ministry time & seminars


Sat afternoon: Social time together, choosing from a range of activities


Pentecost in the Park - 19th May

Sabbatical

When? June to August 2024

Reading, praying, walking, reflecting and making space to hear from God. In August the Kennaughs will be spending the month in Hawaii serving a church on the Big Island.
