- ensuring that a suitable, signed church safeguarding policy is displayed at all times in the church on a safeguarding noticeboard, along with names of current safeguarding officers, national helplines and other suitable information.
- recording of all safeguarding issues and liaising with the Diocesan Safeguarding Officer when appropriate
- working with the leadership team to arrange appropriate safeguarding training
- reporting bi-monthly to PCC
- working with the admin office to process all DBS checks and keep records up to date.

We would love to welcome new people to the team to help us keep everyone safe and ensure we are up to date with all necessary requirements.
